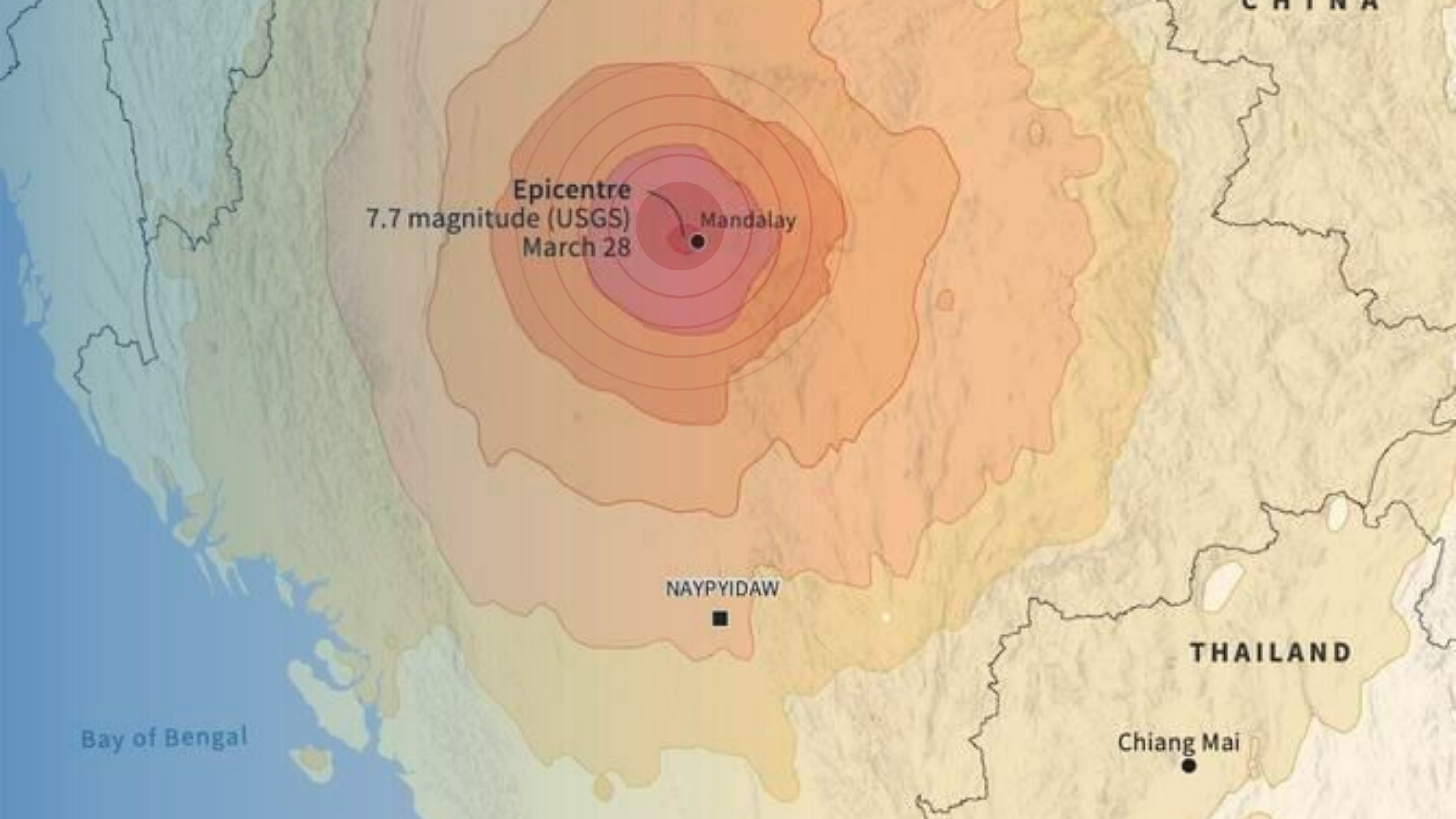

Household Kit Distribution

Emergency household supplies were distributed to a total of 2,072 families across multiple affected areas.



DISTRIBUTION OF EMERGENCY HOUSEHOLD KITS

In response to the urgent needs of displaced families, emergency household kits were distributed to 2,072 families across multiple townships. The distribution covered several key areas: 250 families in Pyawbwe Township, 400 families in Shwethekyin Ward, 200 families in Innwa Township, 170 families across three locations in Tada U Township, and 50 families each in Luwthantan Village and Kondan Village. Additional support was provided to 150 families in Thein Gyi Quarter, 120 families in Amarapura Township, 40 families in A Lel Baung Quarter, 137 families in Pan Ya Southern Village, 215 families in Tada U Township, and 290 families in Thin Ban Village.

In addition to the household kits, solar lights were also provided to those in need, helping to ensure some level of illumination in the midst of darkness. These kits supplied essential items, offering immediate relief and helping families stabilize their daily lives amidst the chaos and loss caused by the earthquake.

MOBILE MEDICAL SUPPORT

Our mobile medical teams were dispatched to six key locations, including Myanmar Theological College, Go Wein Port, Naypu Kone Village, Wesley Church, Shwe Thae Kyin Village, and Pyi Gyi Yan Lone Ward. On March 31, 2025, we provided free medical consultations and treatments to 235 patients. Many of the cases involved injuries sustained from collapsing structures and burns from post-quake fires. The swift intervention of our doctors and nurses alleviated immediate suffering and saved lives.

Shwe Thae Kyin Ward, Mandalay: A Community Struck by a Series of Disasters

In Block 402, Shwe Thae Kyin Ward, Mandalay, a powerful earthquake was followed by a devastating fire and a second quake—damaging over 1,000 homes. Fear and sadness overwhelmed the community.

The Methodist Church (Lower Myanmar) responded with emergency aid—delivering household items, food, and free medications.

A Silent Cry: Helping the Disabled Amid Disaster

A man with a cleft nose, unable to hear or speak, was injured while searching for food during the crisis.

Volunteer doctors from the Methodist Church (Lower Myanmar) cared for his wounds and helped meet his basic needs.

Many disabled individuals silently suffer during disasters. Together, we can bring light into their lives.



Escaping One Danger, Facing Another

As the earthquake struck, a man jumped from the upper floor of a one-story building to survive—but suffered serious injuries to his waist and leg.

He was rushed to Mandalay Orthopaedic Hospital at 7:10 AM on April 4, 2025.

Each survivor carries not just physical wounds, but stories of courage and pain.



The Kitchen Survivor: A Young Woman's Fight for Recovery

A young woman working in a restaurant kitchen was caught in the earthquake. As she tried to escape, a wall collapsed—and a pot of hot oil spilled, burning her face and legs. The Methodist Church (Lower Myanmar), in partnership with Kuo Yu Methodist Church, is supporting her healing journey through prayer, care, and essential aid.



Rebuilding Christ Methodist Church – Mandalay

The Christ Methodist Church in Mandalay sustained severe damage and is currently at risk of collapse. The entire structure has been compromised. We invite all believers to unite in prayer for the rebuilding of this sacred space. In the meantime, we are seeking a temporary location for worship and fellowship.



Rebuilding Homes for Affected Families

Countless homes were destroyed during the earthquake, leaving many families without shelter. We are committed to rebuilding homes, particularly in Inle and surrounding regions. Each house, built with bamboo, zinc roofing, and plywood flooring, costs approximately \$1,700 USD. We welcome all individuals and partners who wish to contribute or participate in this effort.
